

Glossary	Descriptions
Student type	Describes student status example: F - New Undergraduate Student, E - UG-Freshmen Transfer, O - Transfer from Out-of-State, W - Transfer from In-State, D -HS Dual Credit, V - HS-Vocational, C - Continuing, R -Readmit, G - GR-New Grad from Out-of-State, I - GR-New Graduate from In-State, N - GR-New Graduate from NMSU
Admission type	Describes type of admittance (STVADMT) examples: RG - Regular Admission, ND - Non-degree, PR - Provisional Undergraduate, etc
Address type	describes the type of address example: AD - Permanent/Home, BI - Billing, MA - Mailing, etc
Confidential	A value of " Y " (Yes) indicates that the data is confidential and cannot be shared without the consent of the student and a value of " N " (No) or blank indicates that the data can be disclosed/shared for University Business purposes only.
Enrolled/enrollment	Students enrolled in a course at NMSU for a specific term and campus
Early admit	students enrolled at NMSU in the summer immediately following high school graduation
Transfer student	A student who has attended another institution (non-NMSU) previously after graduation from high school
Contract course	Course offered by NMSU, but paid for by another source (not I & G funded)
Travel	NMSU student attending another school through the National Student Exchange or International Student Exchange program, or on a Cooperative Education for a specific term
Primary major	Student's first major entered into INB Banner
Student campus	Campus associated with student's primary(first) campus
Course campus	Campus associated with course Student can be a main campus student, but taking a course at another community college
Duplicated	Students may be repeated multiple times on the report due to multiple majors, minors, enrollment at multiple campuses, etc
Unduplicated	Students will only appear on report once regardless of multiple majors, minors etc.
Academic Interest	Students areas of academic interest at NMSU. Major, minor, concentration, option, graduate certification, supplemental major, teaching field, endorsement
Cumulative GPA, Hours	Student's total gpa and hours accumulated
Term GPA, Hours	Students GPA, hours for one specific term
Access restricted to campus, college, major	Any report indicating that "Security restricted to campus, college, major" indicates that security matrix table is being used to determine which student records you are allow to view.

ACAD-INTEREST-BY-CRS-CMP	Academic Interest data by the campus where student has course enrollment. Example: A main campus student can be in enrolled in a course at a community college and they will be listed as having enrollment at both campuses
EOT	End of Term - data reflects after grading updates
BOT	Beginning of Term - data reflects that most recent values for last term attended
ACAD-INTEREST-BY-FIRST-MJR	Academic Interest data by the student's first major. This identifies students by their primary major. Can be used for enrollment type headcounts.
Cohort	Banner field that contains identified cohort data. Example: Engineering Integrated Learning Community, BA - Business Administration
Event	Snapshot of data at a certain point-in-time. Example: Census, Grading, First day of class, etc
Level	Level of student academic path, students can be on one level at a time (GR -graduate or UG - undergraduate)
Show on Report	Fields available to be included or excluded on a Cognos Report
optional	Used on Cognos "Prompt" page to indicate which parameters are optional
required	Used on Cognos "Prompt" page to indicate which parameters must be selected
Search By	Used on Cognos "Prompt" page to allow user to determine which set of prompts they want to use for data querying. Example: ST-SS-R0020-CLS-ROSTER will allow you to get class list by CRN or course subject, number or section
Census	Date at which NMSU collects enrollment numbers to send to HED. This data usually reflects the 3rd Friday of each semester. This point-in-time snapshot is used for many comparisons throughout each academic year.
